How do I walk with Jesus?

- Reading the Word of God
- Praying from power
- Evangelizing anyone
- Singing for survival
- Sabbathing in and with Jesus
- Pleading/Picturing/Prizing/Preaching the blood of Jesus

How do WE walk with Jesus?

- Loving the people in our lives (Church family, family, world)
- Forgiving the people in our lives
- Gathering with other believers often (large group & small group)
- Fasting and Feasting together
- Running and Resting in the Shelter of the Most High in Uncertain Days
- Praying together (even when we can't be together)
- Serving together

1. Serving starts with surrendering your body. (Rom. 12:1; 1 Cor. 6:19-20; Rom. 8:9)

- Surrender your body to the mercies of God.
- Surrender your body to the living-sacrifice of Jesus.
- Surrender your body in worship and the Word.

2. Serving is sustained with surrendering your mind. (Rom. 12:2-3)

- Surrender your mind to transformation.
- Surrender your mind to grace-filled humility.
- Surrender your mind to faithful truth.

3. Serving is shared with surrendering your will. (Rom. 12:2-21)

- Surrender your will to God's will.
- Surrender your will to use your gifts.
- Surrender your will to love one another.
